MAUNDY THURSDAY SUPPER & WORSHIP (CANTATA & COMMUNION)



On Maundy Thursday, March 28, at 5:15 pm we will have supper together in McLeod Hall. Then we will prepare our hearts for worship in the sanctuary.

Our *Maundy Thursday* service, at 6:30 pm, will transport us back to the Upper Room on that somber final Passover that Jesus celebrated with his friends. The chancel of our church will be transformed into the iconic image of Leonardo DaVinci's masterpiece, The Last Supper.

Thirteen men from our congregation will portray the images of Jesus and the Twelve around the table that night. Each disciple will share a monologue; their own private thoughts on the evening and what is to come in the hours ahead. Interspersed between the monologues will be anthems sung by our Chancel Choir.

Following the drama, the cast, choir, and congregation will celebrate the Lord's Supper together as God's redeemed people. You will not want to miss this unique worship experience as we present The Living Last Supper by composer Ruth Elaine Schram.
